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Notice of Public Hearing

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Commissioners of St. Mary's County, Maryland will conduct a public hearing in the main meeting room of the Chesapeake Building, located at 41770 Baldrige Street, Leonardtown, MD, on September 16, 2014 beginning at 11:45 a.m., for the purpose of receiving public testimony and to consider an amendment to the text of the St. Mary's County Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance (Z-10-02), as amended, (the "Zoning Ordinance"). The Amendment proposed for consideration is as follows:

Text amendment to the Zoning Ordinance:

In Chapter 51, "Use Regulations and Standards," Section 51.3 "Specific Regulations and Standards," amend use type 16 "Dwelling Unit, Multi-Family Residence" to change the requirement to provide recycling from 100 units to 10 units.

Note that as a result of the evidence and comments made at the public hearing, amendments may be made to the proposed ordinance.
